

Ordering Blood Products:

- In the OR: use verbal orders. Do NOT order in Powerchart.
- CSICU: order via Powerchart, unless it's a *massive transfusion* then can call blood bank and request to proceed via verbal orders.
- PACU: order via Powerchart, unless it's a *massive transfusion* then can call blood bank and request to proceed via verbal orders.
- Trauma Bay: if it's an Exp or an MTP use verbal orders.
- Please add a Cerner patient label (one with a barcode) to the paper transfusion record associated with each product (and sign/date the record like usual).
- Currently no need from transfusion medicine's perspective to enter the unit number (the "sticker") into our anaesthetic record in Surgient. If you would like to continue to do so for your own purposes you can add a comment here:
